Fall is here and we're delighted to share some news that's as invigorating as the season itself. Big changes are coming to our community amenities in 2024, and we can't wait to tell you all about them!

#### A NEW AMENITY CENTER IS ALMOST HERE!

Firstly, our new amenity center that's nearing its completion. This beautiful new facility promises to elevate your living experience in our community. We're buzzing with excitement and can't wait to share more details and the grand opening date with you soon.

#### A REVAMPED RESERVATION PROCESS FOR OUR AMENITIES

Our community is growing, and so is the demand for our wonderful amenities. To ensure everyone has an equal chance to enjoy these spaces, we're introducing a new reservation process. Starting October 1, 2023, any bookings made for dates after January 1, 2024, will be subject to these new rules. If you've already signed a reservation agreement and paid a deposit for a date after the New Year, it will still be honored under the old rules.

Now, let's talk about what these changes mean for you. All amenity reservations will be divided into two time blocks each day: one from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., and another from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m. This scheduling will apply to all our amenities, including the clubhouse, pavilion, sports fields, and courts. We're also enforcing a limit on reservations. Each household will be able to reserve an amenity up to four times a year. We've always had this restriction but have not needed to enforce it in the past.

As for pricing, it will be \$200 for a half-day and \$400 for a full day. Deposits will remain at \$250 for the clubhouse and \$100 for all other amenities. Please note that cancellations made within 30 days will result in a forfeiture of 50% of the deposit, and cancellations within 14 days will result in a 100% forfeiture of the deposit.

We're incredibly excited about these changes and believe they will make our community even more enjoyable for everyone. Keep an eye out for more updates, and as always, feel free to reach out with any questions or concerns.
