




MANAGER'S NOTE

Time to Plant Trees!

Now is the perfect time to plant trees in Central Texas. Planting now allows trees to establish new roots before summer's brutal heat. The best time to plant a new tree was 20 years ago; the second-best time is now.

Exterior Lighting

Did you know that, just like any other improvement, exterior lighting requires approval from the architectural committee? We have seen an increase in LED soffit lights being installed without approval. If that sounds like you, don't worry! As long as the lights conform to our community's design guidelines, the approval process is quick and easy. You can download an application from the "Homeowner Resources" section of our website.

Please review the design guidelines applicable to these types of lights: Soffit lights must be permanently and professionally installed. All wires and cables for any exterior lighting must be properly concealed; exposed wires and cables are not allowed. Soffit lights must be either recessed or contained within color-matched channels that are purpose-made by the manufacturer to ensure a uniform appearance. Generic channels or conduits are not allowed.

Lights that do not meet these requirements will not be approved. Be sure to obtain approval before beginning the installation or construction of any improvement to avoid the need for costly changes. It's not too late to get approval if you've already installed them. Just send us the application and information about the lighting system, and we'll process it for you.
