Parking Reminders

Howdy neighbors! Parking might seem like a small part of daily life, but it has a big impact on our community's safety and appearance. By following our community's guidelines, we can keep Blackhawk looking great and running smoothly for everyone.

Community Parking Do's and Don'ts

Where to Park

Keep vehicles in garages or driveways. Our covenants only allow two vehicles outside the garage on the driveway. Additional vehicles should be parked in the garages.

Sidewalks Are for Walking

Make sure your car isn't blocking the sidewalk when parked in the driveway. This ensures that pedestrians, especially kids and those with strollers or wheelchairs, can pass safely.

Street Parking

We know it's tempting, but overnight parking on streets is against HOA rules. While the HOA can't remove cars from public streets, homeowners violating our guidelines may be fined.

Inoperable Vehicles

If you have a car that isn't running, it must be stored in your garage or moved off-site. Vehicles with expired registration are considered inoperable.

Want to Report a Parking Issue?

If you spot a parking violation—like street parking or inoperable vehicles—let us know! Just be sure to provide details about who the vehicle belongs to so we can follow up. Without that info, we can't enforce the rules.

A Note About State Parking Laws

Some parking problems go beyond HOA rules and fall under Texas law. Did you know that parking on sidewalks, too close to fire hydrants, or blocking driveways is illegal? If you see violations like these, contact the **Travis County Sheriff's Office** for help. The HOA can't enforce state laws, but local authorities are happy to step in if you reach out to them.

By working together and being mindful of where we park, we can keep Blackhawk safe, accessible, and beautiful for all. Thanks for doing your part, and as always, reach out if you have questions or concerns!

Whole House Battery Backup Systems

As whole house battery backup systems grow in popularity, new guidelines have been added to our community's Design Guidelines. Installation requires approval from the ACC, which will ensure the systems meet these requirements. These guidelines include placement along the side of the house, required screening for some systems, maintenance standards, and conditions for removal.
